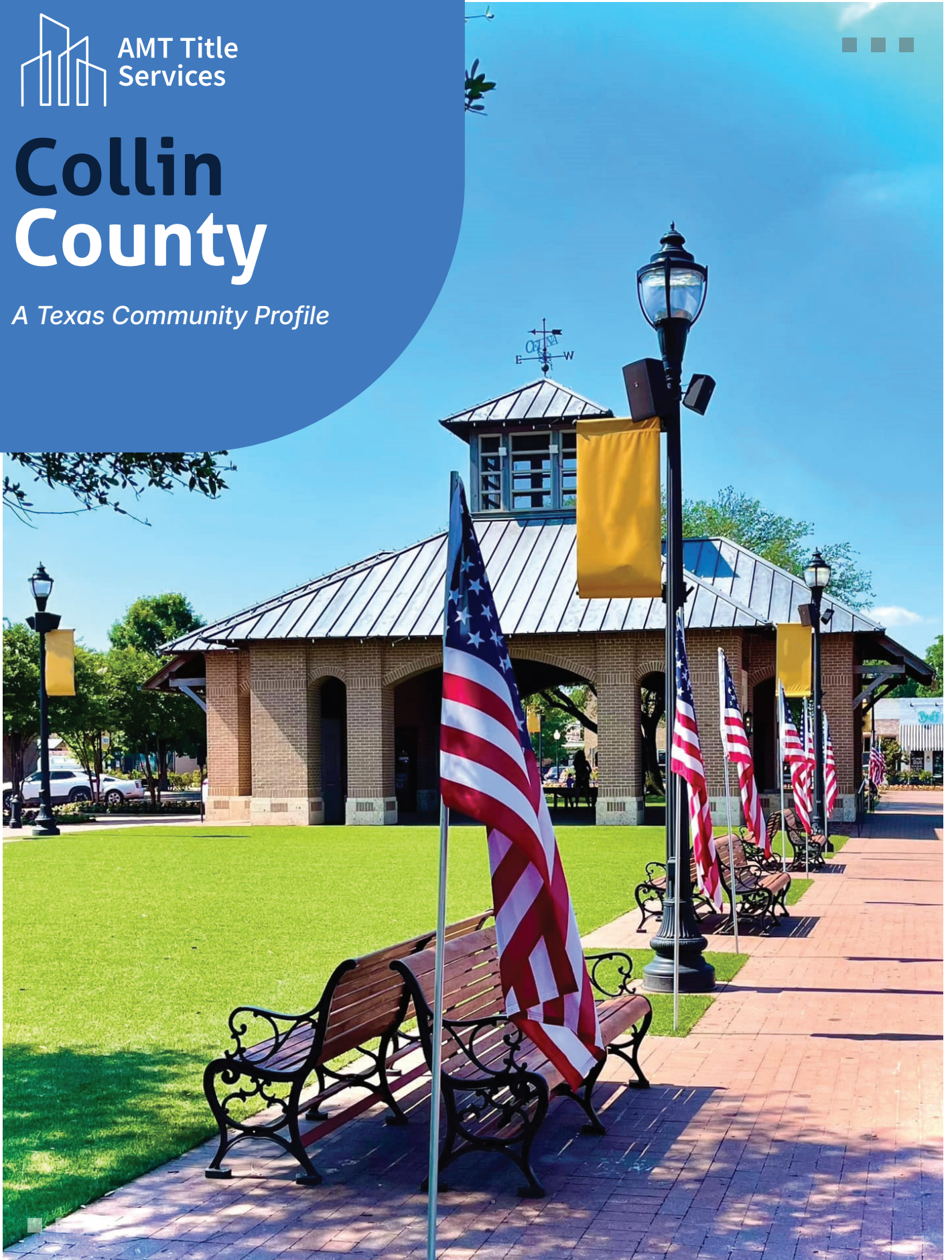

### **Rodenbaugh Aquatic & Fitness Center** 110 E. Rivercrest Blvd

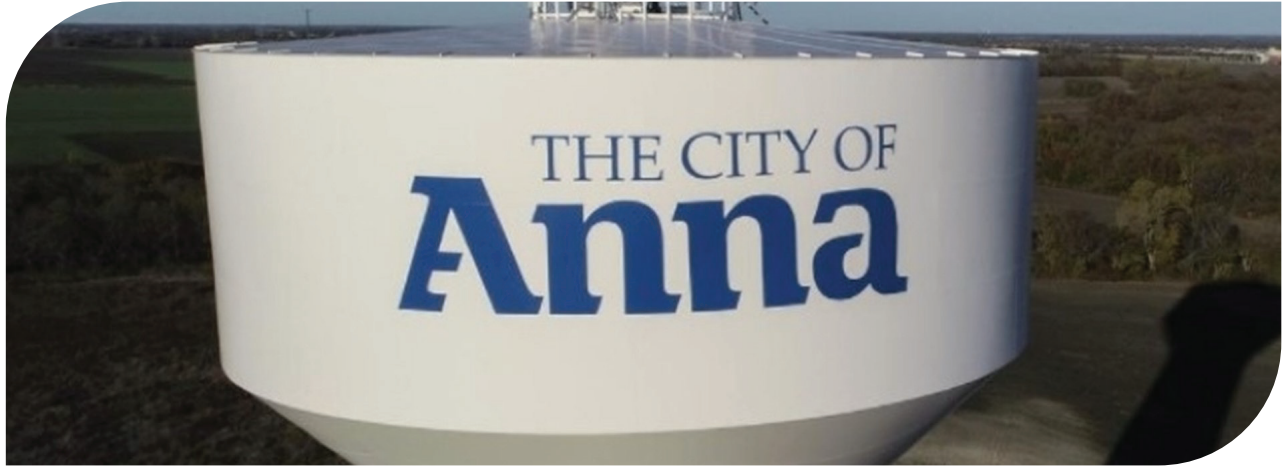

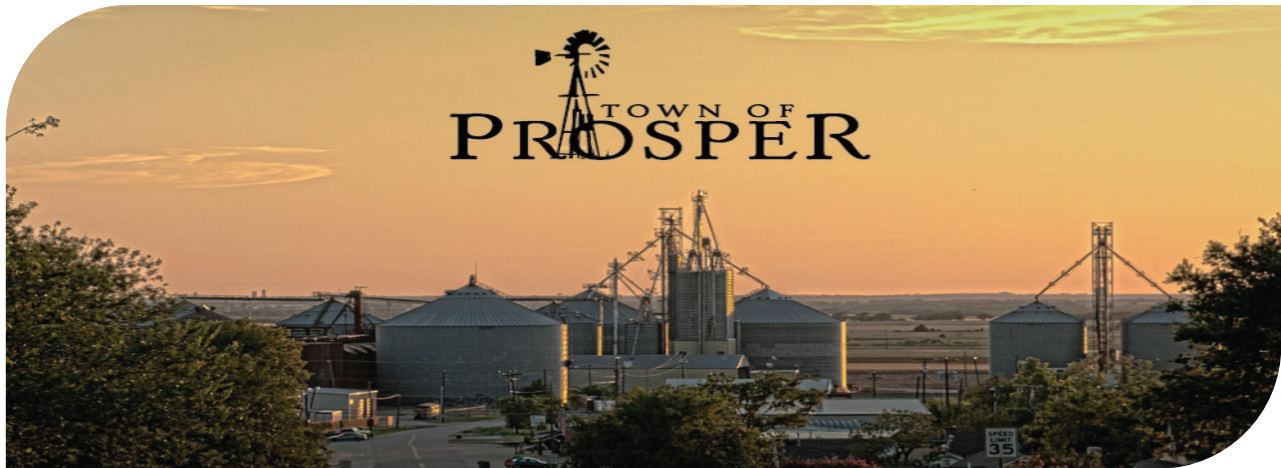
